
The majority of our students follow a course comprising three A Level subjects or equivalent.

Private study plays a key role in Sixth Form life. For every hour spent in lessons, students complete one hour of rigorous private study. This expectation helps students develop the discipline needed for success in further education and the workplace.


THE SIXTH FORM CENTRE

The Sixth Form is based within a dedicated part of the school. This area includes two study rooms with ICT facilities and other resources essential for effective study, alongside a wellbeing room and a social area for exclusive Sixth Form use.

Lessons take place across the school site, and the Study Centre is open before and after school each day for private study. Members of the Sixth Form team are based in this area, ensuring there is always someone available if you need support or guidance.

Students also have access to our excellent sports facilities, including a fitness and weights suite promoting physical wellbeing alongside academic progress.







At Brakenhale, we recognise that success extends beyond grades. Alongside excellent academic teaching, we offer a strong Character and Skills Education Programme. Students are encouraged to develop attributes such as leadership, independence, and teamwork, ensuring they are fully prepared for their next steps.

Students have opportunities to make an impact within the school community and beyond, including involvement in Model United Nations, World Challenge, school council, and a wide range of enrichment and extra-curricular activities.
