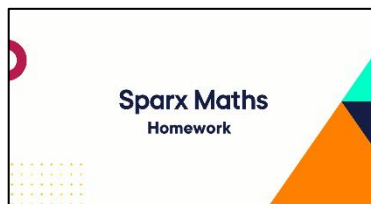

How to use Sparx Maths Homework

Bookwork Checks

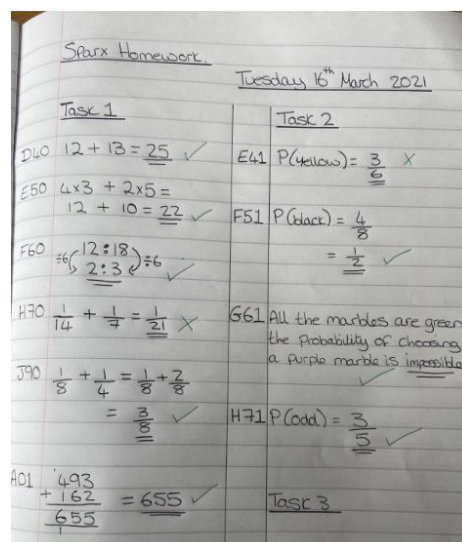
- Sparx will check that you are writing down your answers
- In Bookwork check you will need to input the answer for that bookwork code.
- It is really important to write down all of your workings and your answer clearly

If you fail the bookwork check, **you will have to do the question again!**

Even if you got it right the first time!

What does Good Bookwork Look Like?

- Clear titles
- Date
- Workings out
- Answers
- Self Marked
- Bookwork codes
- Do this in the back of your book

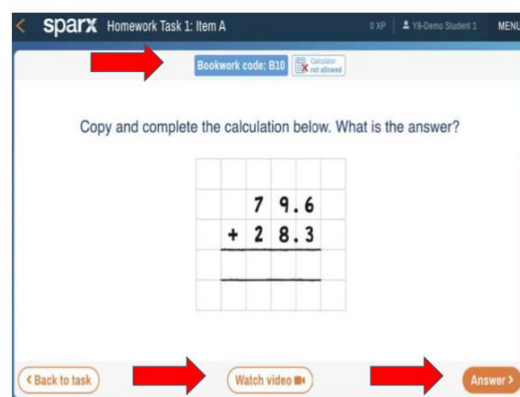


Please do not cross out your wrong answers. We learn from our mistakes!

Answering your Questions

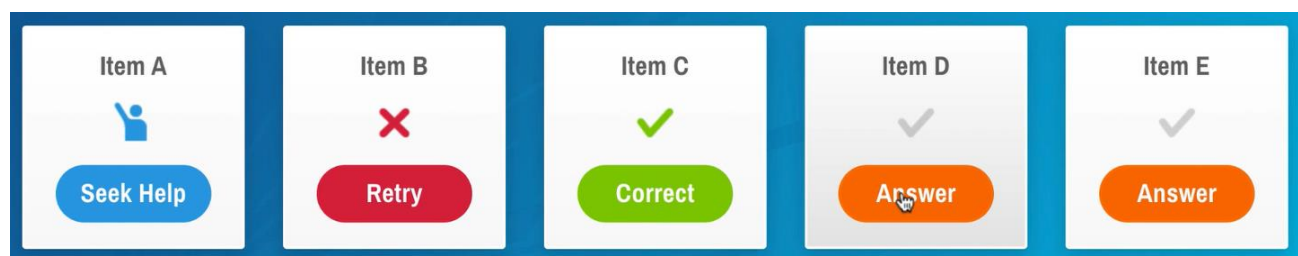
Please make a note of where the following locations are:

Seek Help

- If you answer a question incorrectly three times, the **Seek Help** icon will automatically appear
- Please contact **your main maths teacher directly or attend a help session** to get additional support



Please note: You can return and re attempt the question at any time by clicking the seek help icon under the question.

Remember: All tasks must have at least one correct answer if it shows seek help and you do not attempt the question again then it will be marked as incomplete.

Please Remember...

It is really important that your answers are **yours and yours alone.**

If someone else

- Does the work for you
- Tells you the answers without you having worked them out for yourself
- Helps you too much

You will get homework that is too hard for you!

To help the algorithm get it right for you, please do the following...

- Watch the videos
- Make the first attempt for each question yourself

After the first attempt at each question you may then seek help.

Help Sessions

We offer drop in help sessions at the following times, in room B11:

- Monday - Lunchtime
- Tuesday - Lunchtime

These sessions enable you to seek help on three occasions before the deadline.

Homework deadline is 11pm Tuesday.

Detentions

Detentions will be set for the following.

- Homework not completed at **100%**
- Homework not completed by the deadline
- Homework that is completed after the deadline

Detentions details:

- Detentions will be **45** Minutes long
- You will be required to stay the full **45** minute duration even if you have completed your homework during this time
