High Quality Teaching and Learning | Aiming High

At Brakenhale we believe that great teaching leads to great outcomes. Teachers regularly engage in training and in the sharing of practices so we continue to provide high quality teaching and learning.

Lessons are structured so that students start each one of them by recalling prior learning. This refreshing of their knowledge enables them to progress with new content which our teachers explicitly instruct. Lessons have an opportunity for all students to practise what they have learned and this is checked in a variety of ways.

We believe that our brains are like any other muscle. Like other muscles, it needs exercising. We endeavour to show our students that nothing is fixed and that our 'intelligence' can be enhanced through persistent and purposeful effort. As a staff body, we work hard to ensure our lessons not only engage our students but stretch their thinking. This, in turn, enables them to attain excellent outcomes.

We endeavour to raise aspirations through everything we offer in our school.

For all students we set aspirational targets. This is deliberate so that they can aim high and excel themselves in each subject. As a result, students' entry into the Sixth Form is based on their GCSE results.

Our curriculum is broad, balanced and designed to offer memorable experiences. There is a blend of academic and vocational qualifications at both Key Stage 4 (Years 10 and 11) and 5 (Years 12 and 13), including partnerships with local colleges and businesses. This enables students to aspire high and leave Brakenhale with the achievements and qualifications to succeed thereafter.

Furthermore we strive to ensure that there is effective communication between home and school. This creates a partnership so that your child's education is co-ordinated, allowing everyone to raise both their aspirations and achievement.

As a school we firmly believe in developing the 'whole child'. Yes, academic excellence matters; their development as students into young adults matters as much.

We have staff members who forge links to the surrounding businesses and youth projects. These offer opportunities to our students so that their personal and enterprising skills are evergrowing. The Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme covers everything from social skills to study skills, understanding your body and internet safety to preparing a CV. Each year group follows an age relevant programme of study designed to support their personal development. This is delivered by their own form tutors.

Extra-curricular opportunities are essential to nurturing students. For example, we offer quality sport, dance, drama, music and art opportunities. Students can represent Brakenhale in local and national competitions in their chosen field. A distinctive feature here at Brakenhale is the Combined Cadet Force (CCF). This programme is on offer for Year 8 to 13 students to deliver leadership, teamwork and adventure opportunities. In partnership with the British Forces, the CCF programme allows students to challenge themselves across a range of activities from first aid and survival, parading, shooting and adventurous activities.

The prestigious Duke of Edinburgh award has continued to grow in success at Brakenhale. Students can access the Bronze, Silver and Gold awards from Year 9 onwards.

Throughout the year, Brakenhale students are fortunate to access a range of academic, career, adventure and rewards trips. Working in partnership with universities, businesses and organisations we can offer students a diverse delivery of educational and work related skill opportunities.

These opportunities are a testimony to everyone working together and for each other. The way in which strong relationships are formed between staff, students and families, due to our common goal of seeing every child achieve the best they can be, is clear for all to see.



Dynamic Futures - Post 16 | Aiming High

Brakenhale Sixth Form is 'Outstanding' and we are incredibly proud of our provision.

Over the past few years our results have consistently shown our students are making excellent progress and this has led to a rapid change in university and apprenticeship destinations. This year we have had students go to universities near and far as well as students embarking on apprenticeship courses in their field of interest. We are delighted that our students are aiming high and are ambitious with their career choices.

Our curriculum is broad and offers a range of A-Levels and BTEC Level 3 courses to cater for our student intake. Beyond the curriculum students are asked to volunteer and support the younger students as well as completing an enrichment course such as Sports Leaders, the Extended Project or Arts Award. The Student Leadership Team is led by Post-16 students who are keen to share ideas and commitment to our school. We encourage this as we believe in the development of the students' characters as well as their academic excellence.
