## Careers Baker Clause Statement

### Introduction

This policy statement sets out the Brakenhale School's arrangements for managing the access of providers to students at the school for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

### Student entitlement

**All students in Years 7-13 are entitled:**

- To find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point.
- To hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships – through options events, assemblies and group discussions and taster events.
- To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

### Opportunities for access

The school offers a comprehensive Careers Education, information, advice and guidance programme and an overview of this programme can be seen in the school's Careers Mission Statement which can be seen on the school's website.

A number of events, integrated into the school careers programme, will offer providers of education or training an opportunity to come into school to speak to students and/or their parents/carers.

Providers should speak to the contact named above to identify the most suitable opportunity for access to Brakenhale students.

### **Local College Access**

Local colleges providing technical education are invited to deliver talks about their courses to students every year. We have excellent links with our feeder college, Bracknell & Wokingham College, with a dedicated link who supports students with the application process and progression to college.

### **Apprenticeship Providers**

Apprenticeship companies and specialist providers such as Amazing Apprenticeships, AIM Apprenticeships and Pathway CTM deliver apprenticeship workshops to students in Year 10, 11, 12 and 13. Events and opportunities are also shared with students via tutors and student emails.

**ALL** students take part in **National Apprenticeship Week** through targeted tutor time activities and PSHE lessons. Webinars and resources shared by the Government organisation, 'Amazing Apprenticeship' are



used for this purpose. The parent version of these resources is also made available to parents via the website and email.

### **Annual Careers Fair**

In addition ALL students in Years 7 to 13 attend an annual Careers Fair which includes exhibitors from all our local colleges and apprenticeship providers (NB it was not possible to host a Careers Fair during the Covid-19 pandemic).

### **SEND, High Achievers & Disadvantaged Careers Provision**

We have focused opportunities targeted at SEND, High Achieving and Disadvantaged students with bespoke programmes which colleges and apprenticeship providers may also wish to consider supporting.

### **Prospectuses and Information**

Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their prospectus or other relevant course literature at our Learning Resources Centre. The LRC is open to all students before and after school and at break and lunch times.

### **Sharing of information with students**

All students have email access and we are willing to share open event information and opportunities with targeted students.
