About the course:

Join us for a fun, inclusive, and hands-on summer writing adventure, designed to build confidence, explore creativity, and celebrate self-expression through poetry. Each week offers something new - from free verse and spoken word, to shape poems and sensory collages. No experience needed - just your imagination!

About me - why I write:

Writing has always been my way of making sense of the world. Growing up in a sometimes chaotic environment, I found peace in music, reading, and scribbling thoughts into diaries - before smartphones were even a thing! I didn't always feel I could speak openly, so I turned to the page instead, writing through emotions I couldn't express out loud.

Years later, working in challenging environments and rediscovering the power of words through music, I picked up the pen again. What began as a personal outlet soon turned into something bigger: a way to connect with others. I started running creative writing sessions in prisons and community groups, where I witnessed firsthand the incredible stories and talent that emerge when people feel safe to share.

Now, I write not just for myself, but to empower others, spark conversations, and create spaces where every voice matters.
